# BYOD...

Year 3-6 students can bring a personally owned device to school for the purpose of learning.

It is important to note that students are **invited** to bring their own device. It is not an **expectation**.



# Why BYOD?

**Bring Your Own Device** allows students to have one to one time on a device that is set up for their specific learning needs.

- *Encourages self-managing, connected, reflective and creative dispositions*
- *Personalized learning*
- *Encourages responsibility*
- *Preparing for the future*



# Why BYOD?

- Vision of NZ Curriculum:  
*“Young people who will be confident, connected, actively involved, and lifelong learners.”*
- Supporting the DT and wider curriculum
- Enables collaboration and creativity
- Increases equity and engagement for all learners
- It is NOT a replacement for pen and paper

# Security

## *Online:*

- Teacher in room
- N4L filtering network
- Supervision via School Domain (Two internet safety officers)
- Hapara Dashboard (can see all screens)

## *Offline:*

- Cybersafety / BYOD Agreement
- No sharing of personal devices
- Locked at break times

# The Process

- Find a device that works for you and your learner (preferably a chromebook)
- You set up the chromebook with the school email & a personal account
- Complete a BYOD Agreement with your learner and return it to school (Google Form will be set up to make this faster)
- The Digital Technologies team will set up the device on the school BYOD network
